

moving out disposal tips

Help keep the University District safe and clean by properly disposing of unwanted items.

Take larger furniture to a drop location

Between 7/28 - 8/12, locations will be available for FREE disposal of couches, mattresses, desks and other large items. Visit universitydistrict.org/move.

Place smaller household items in a trash container

DO NOT place large items inside a container unless it's at a designation furniture drop location. Unwanted household items should go inside an available trash container.

Donate items that are in good, usable condition

Do good and don't just throw away! Household items, clothing, furniture and food can be donated to area non-profits. For a suggested list to donate visit universitydistrict.org/move.

disposal tips & locations

If you are not able to take your furniture to a drop location, find a safe place on the ground in an alley or by the curb.

DO NOT place furniture inside a trash container

DO NOT place furniture in front or beside of a trash container

DO NOT block alleys with unwanted furniture

DO NOT lean furniture against buildings or garages

DO NOT disassemble furniture pieces
